A number of Jewish women living in Barbados are ready to start using the Mikvah. Additionally, hundreds of tourists visit Barbados annually and often need the use of a Mikvah. The construction of a beautiful, new, modern Mikvah on the island will encourage and enhance the performance of this special mitzvah on an entirely new level.
